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SECTION C - SUMMARY OF THE RESEARCH PROPOSAL

A registrar and masters in medicine student, TM Pamacheche who will be supervised by Dr. S Varugheese and Prof. H Saloojee of the Paediatric and Child Health Department submitted a proposal for aproval. The study is entitled **“A description of the clinical profile and case management of paediatric patients admitted with measles to Charlotte Maxeke Johannesburg Academic Hospital”**, it is a quantitative, descriptive study. The study’s objectives are:

Main Objective:

- To describe the patient profile namely patient demographics, predisposing factors, clinical presentation, management and outcomes of children admitted with measles.

Secondary objective:

- To describe the public health aspects of case management of patients, including notification and contact tracing.

The study will include review of case records and measles case investigation forms of paediatric patients admitted with suspected measles between June 2009 and May 2010. The sample size will be a 100.

Ethics approval for the study was obtained from the University of Witwatersrand (Human Research Ethics Committee). The researcher will observe all the Helsinki Declaration principles in conducting this study and will adhere to all terms stated in the accompanying letter of agreement between researcher and GDHSD. Furthermore, before commencing with recruitment of participants and data collection at the identified site, permission will be requested from the CEO’s of the selected hospital. Lastly, the researchers and supervisor shall ensure that at all time during the project, data collection does not interfere with service delivery.

The study has no financial implication for the department.
