### **OUTCOME OF THE DEGREE: MASTER OF SCIENCE IN BUILDING**

Please note that, according to the Standing Orders of the University (A34), you have a **maximum period 3 months** in which to complete these corrections. After these three months, a **pro rata fee** will be raised. Any corrections **exceeding a six months** period, would require an application for extension to the Graduate Studies Committee for approval prior to the end of the six month period.

Once these corrections have been made, we require **2 single sided unbound copies** and an **electronic copy** of your **corrected research report**, a copy of your cover **page, abstract and list of corrections**, as well as the attached **final submission form**.

Graduation takes place on **5 December 2018**. Please ensure that the required submission reaches the Faculty Office by **26 October 2018 (six weeks) prior** to this if you wish to graduate on the above-mentioned date.

May I draw your attention to Rule G.30 which states the following:

1. A candidate upon whom a higher degree has been conferred by the University and who subsequently publishes or republishes the thesis, dissertation or other work, in whole or part, shall indicate on the title page or in the preface, or if this not appropriate, in a footnote, that such thesis, dissertation or other work has been approved for that degree by the University.
2. A candidate for a higher degree shall not be entitled to the return of the copies of the thesis, dissertation or other work which has been submitted for the degree.
