GRAPHIC REPRESENTATION OF THE EVOLUTION OF ROOF FORMS

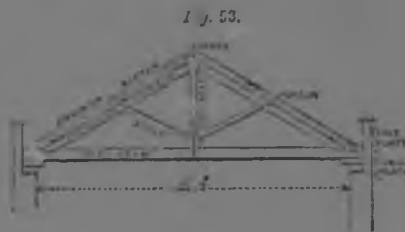
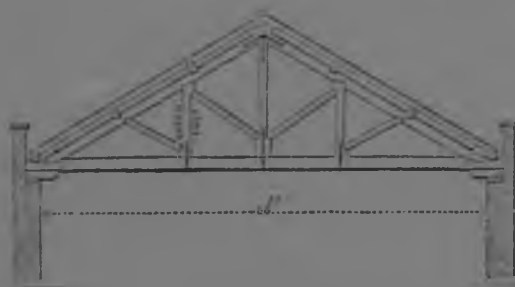
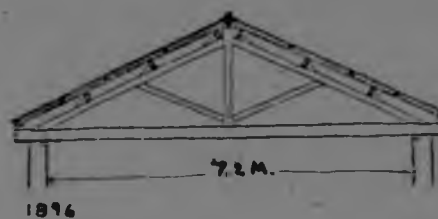
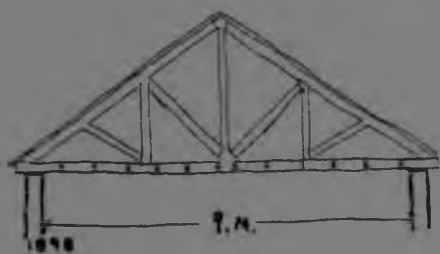
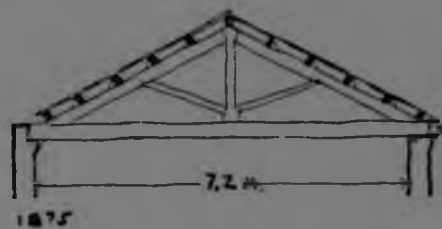

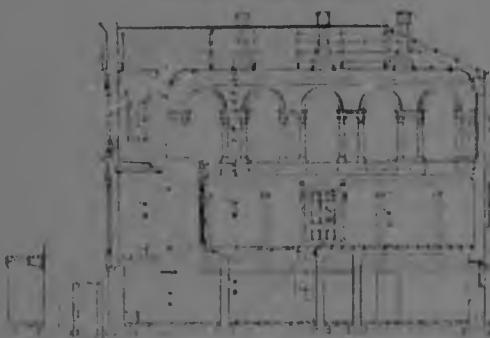
PLAN OF COURT ROOM CEILING



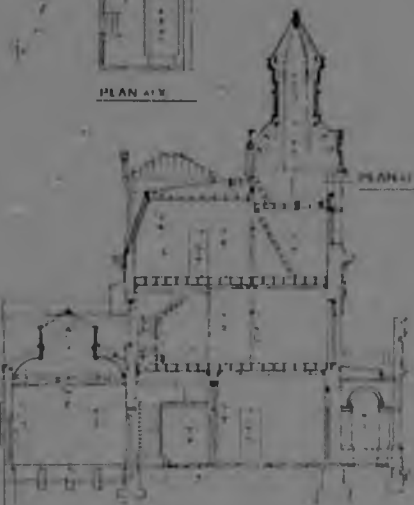

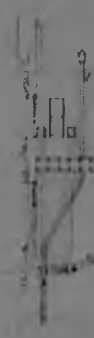
