However, if you decide to participate, I will ask your permission to tape-record the interview session. No one other than the researcher and the supervisor will have access to the tapes. The tapes will be kept in a locked cabinet for two years following any publications or for six years if no publications emanate from the study. A copy of your interview transcript without any identifying information will be stored permanently in a locked cupboard and may be used for future research.

Please be assured that your name and personal details will be kept confidential and no identifying information will be included in the final research report. The results of the research may also be used for

academic purposes (including books, journals and conference proceedings) and a summary of findings will be made to available to participants on request.
