Development Evaluation Training in Africa (DETA) is a practice-based Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E) course certified by Wits University. The course promotes evidence-informed decision-making by building M&E skills on the continent.

DETA 2022 offers:

- ▶ Internationally recognised speakers and presenters: Our speakers and presenters are thought-leaders in evaluation on the continent and globally. They have extensive M&E experience on the continent.
- **Self-paced learning:** Online modules for participants to learn at their own pace wherever they are. Learning is complemented by live discussions and presentations.
- ▶ Interaction with peers: Participants will also benefit from peer to peer learning and sharing of experiences.
- ▶ Topical and relevant evaluation debates: Participants will engage with current evaluation discourse and thinking that is global and has a direct impact on their work. This is the ideal time to contribute to shaping evaluation for the African context.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT FROM DETA 2022?

Participants will gain an improved understanding of key evaluation approaches and current and emerging thinking in evaluation. They will be able to reflect on how topical issues such as transformation and indigenization of evaluation can be applied in their practice. Participants and presenters will also advance the Made-in-Africa Evaluation conversation.
