
ABSTRACT

This study conducted an analysis of the Green Infrastructure Policy in Tbilisi, Georgia with the aim of determining its failures and successes. Green infrastructure is the interconnection of elements such as green areas, and natural features of the surroundings. Through the scrutiny of various documents such as the Green City Action Plan and other secondary sources, the study was able to determine the successes and failure of implementing green infrastructure in Tbilisi, Georgia.
