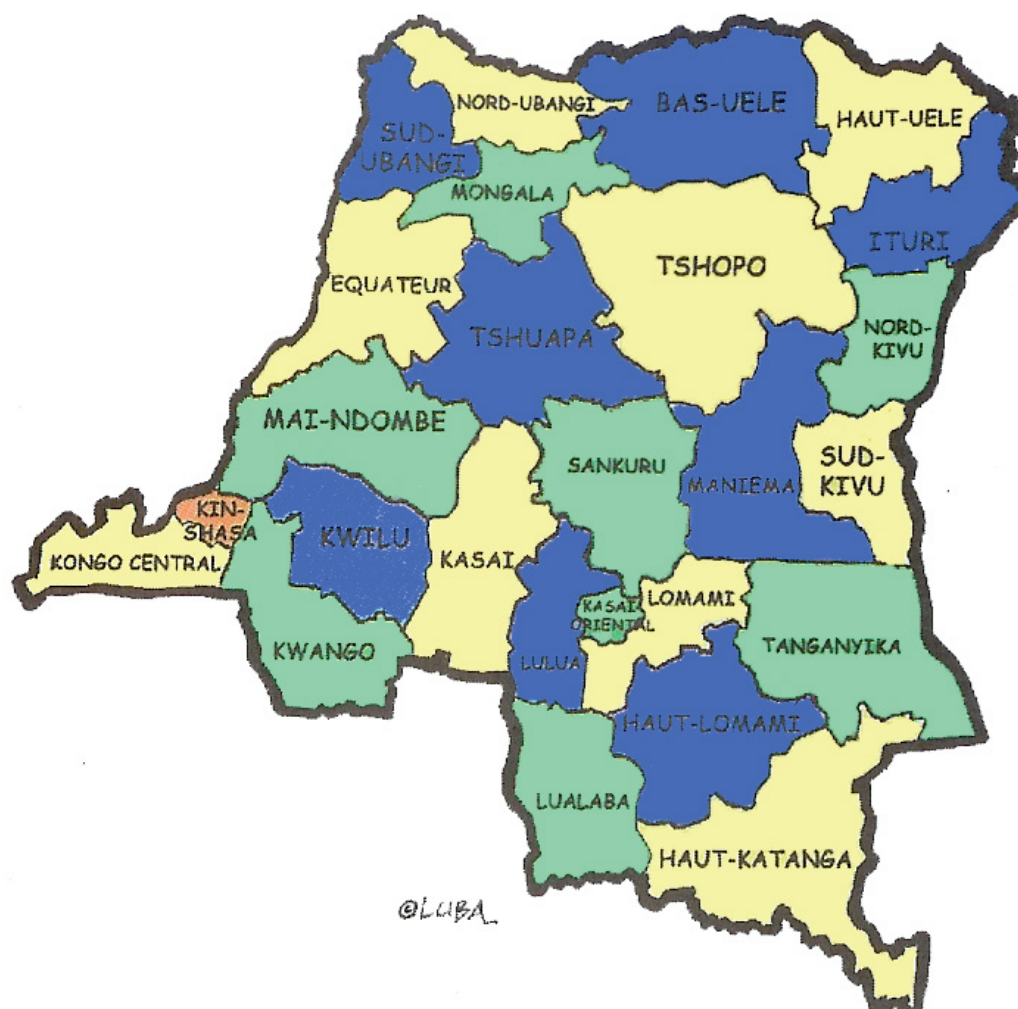
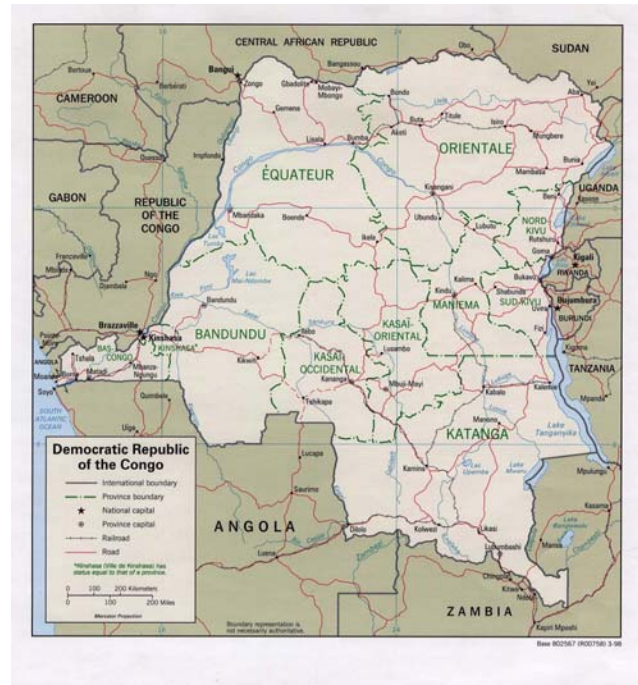

Maps of the Democratic Republic of Congo, agreed in the CNS and taken up again in the current Constitution promulgated on the 18 of February 2006 (extracted from www.radiookapi.net) and of Zaire

N.B. In 1997, the Democratic Republic of Congo conserved the same number of provinces than in Mobutu's Zaire. However, some of them changed the name. For instance, the Province of Haut-Zaire (High Zaire) became with Laurent-Désiré Kabila "Province Orientale" (Eastern Province); Shaba became Katanga, and Bas-Zaire (Low Zaire) became Bas-Congo (Low Congo).

N.B. The agreed map of the democratic South Africa in the 1993 negotiations conserved the same repartition of provinces. However, some names changed: the Northern Transvaal became in 1993 the Northern Province, today LIMPOMPO. The Eastern Transvaal is now MPUMALANGA, and the Orange Free State is FREE STATE.
