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DESCRIPTION:

The research is a part fulfillment of the requirements of the University of the Witwatersrand towards the attainment of a Masters degree in Adult Education.

The purpose of this research is multiple. Most importantly it is to investigate various ways in which Kha Ri Gude either prepares or fails to prepare adult learners for further learning in the ABET systems. This is done precisely by interrogating how the use of mother tongue is assisting learners in their learning process.
