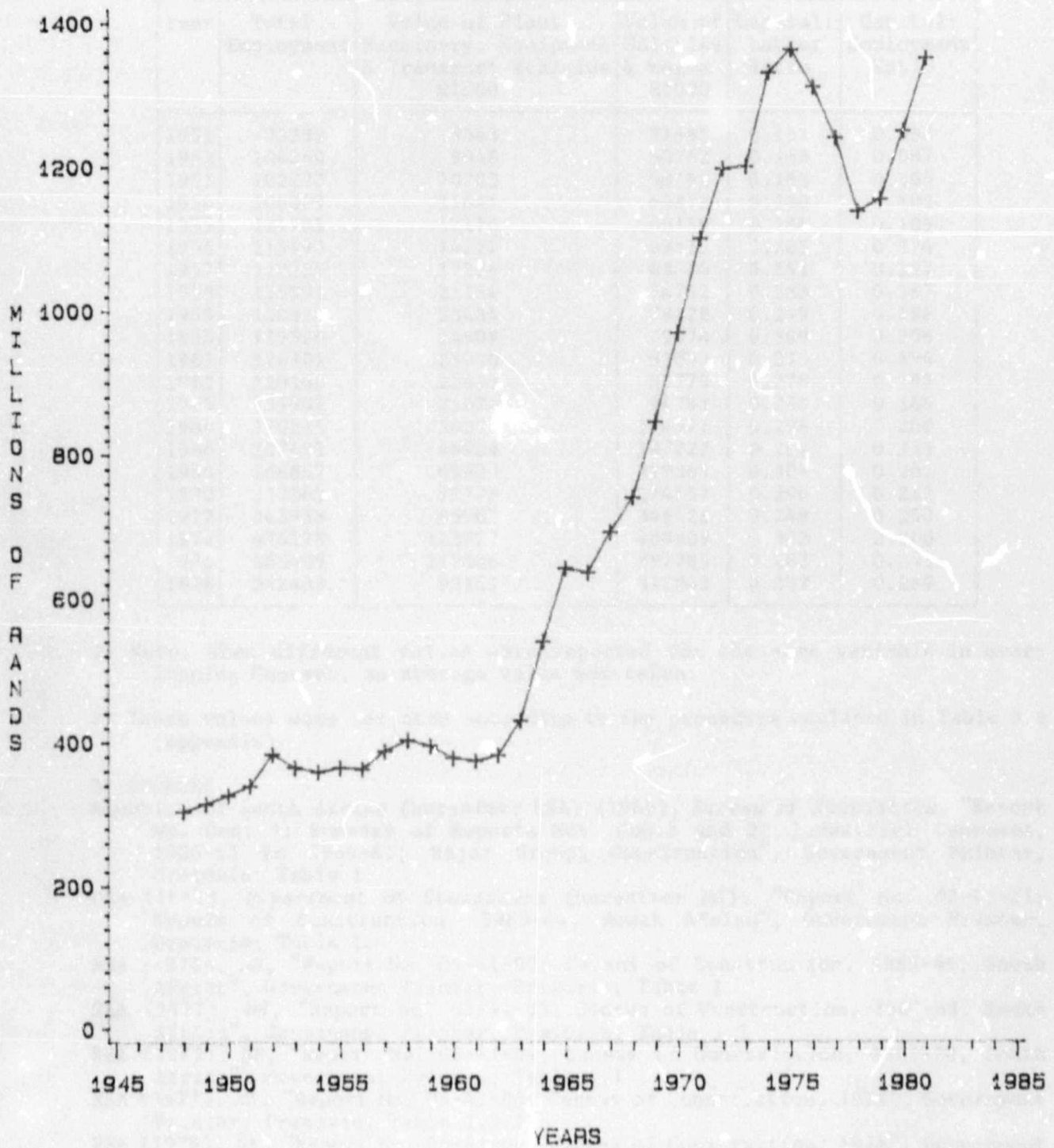

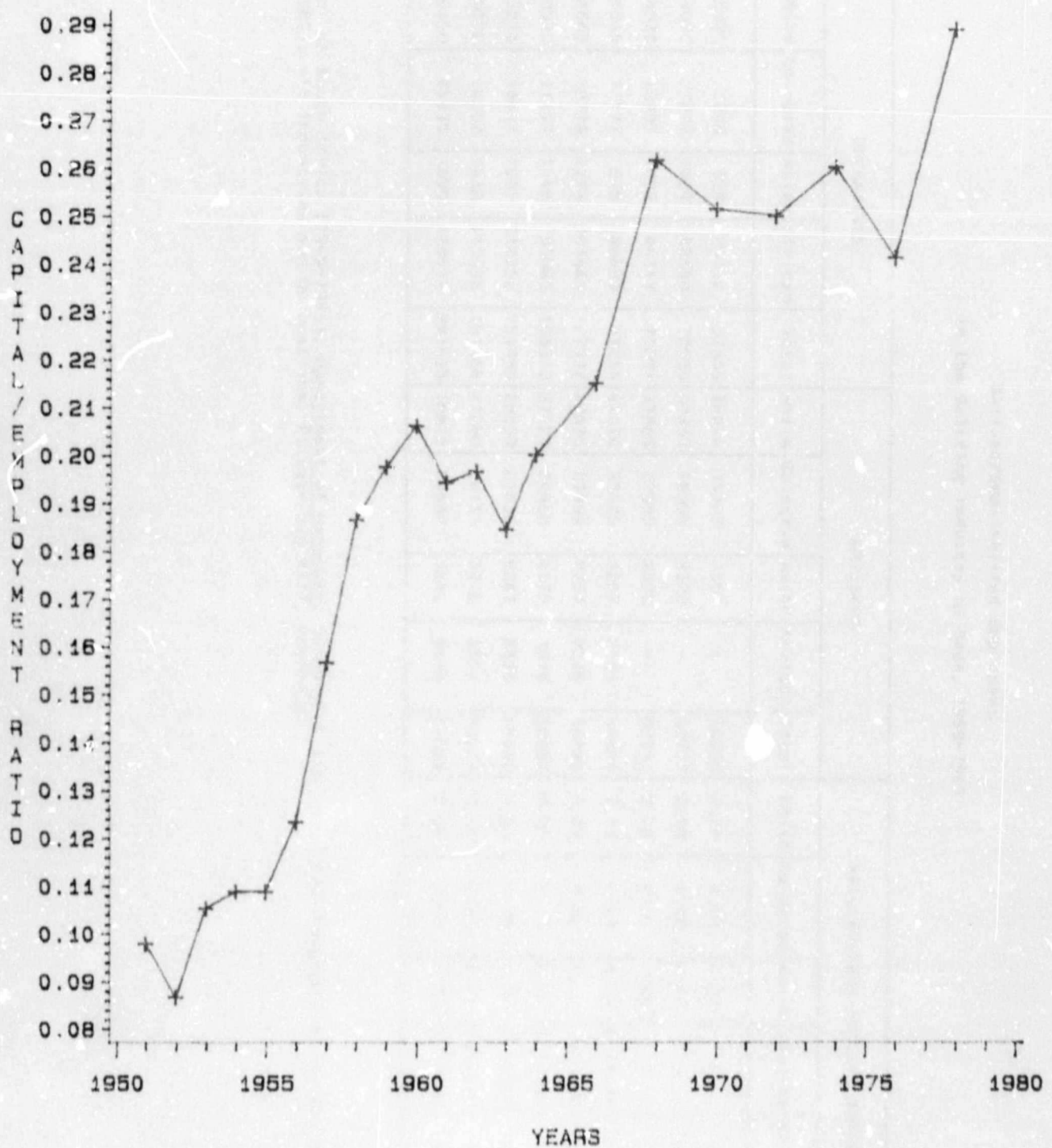

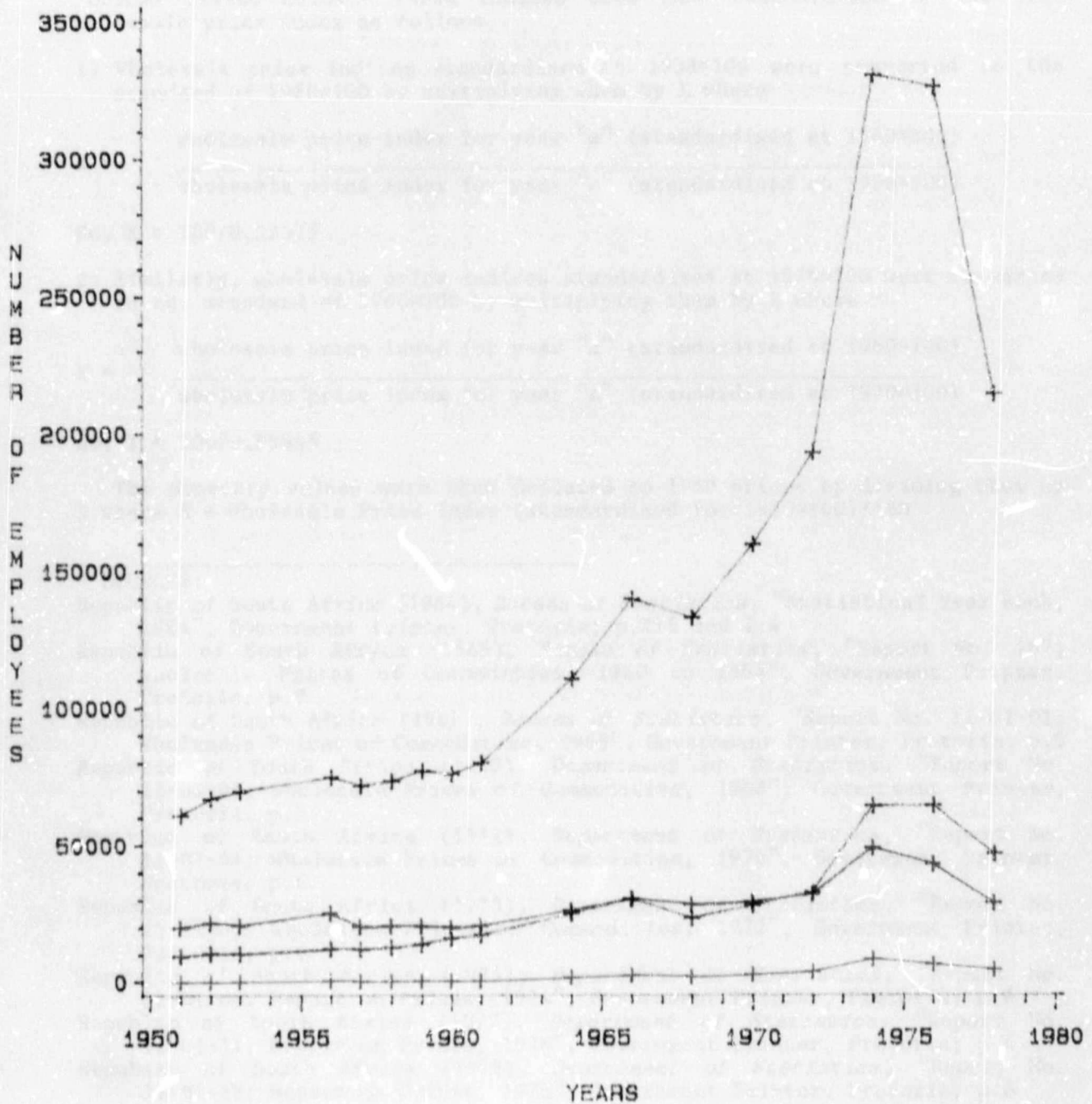

TABLE 3.6

Wholesale Price Deflation Method

All monetary values were deflated to the standard of 1960 prices according to the following procedure. The Wholesale Price Indices were obtained from the sources listed below.* These indices were then standardised to the 1960 wholesale price index as follows.

- 1) Wholesale price indices standardised at 1938=100 were converted to the standard of 1960=100 by multiplying them by X where

$$X = \frac{\text{wholesale price index for year "a" (standardised at 1960=100)}}{\text{wholesale price index for year "a" (standardised at 1938=100)}}$$

So, $X = 100/0,32373$

- 2) Similarly, wholesale price indices standardised at 1970=100 were converted to the standard of 1960=100 by multiplying them by X where

$$X = \frac{\text{wholesale price index for year "a" (standardised at 1960=100)}}{\text{wholesale price index for year "a" (standardised at 1970=100)}}$$

So, $X = 100/0,95446$

The monetary values were then deflated to 1960 prices by dividing them by X where $X = \text{Wholesale Price Index (standardised for 1960=100)}/100$

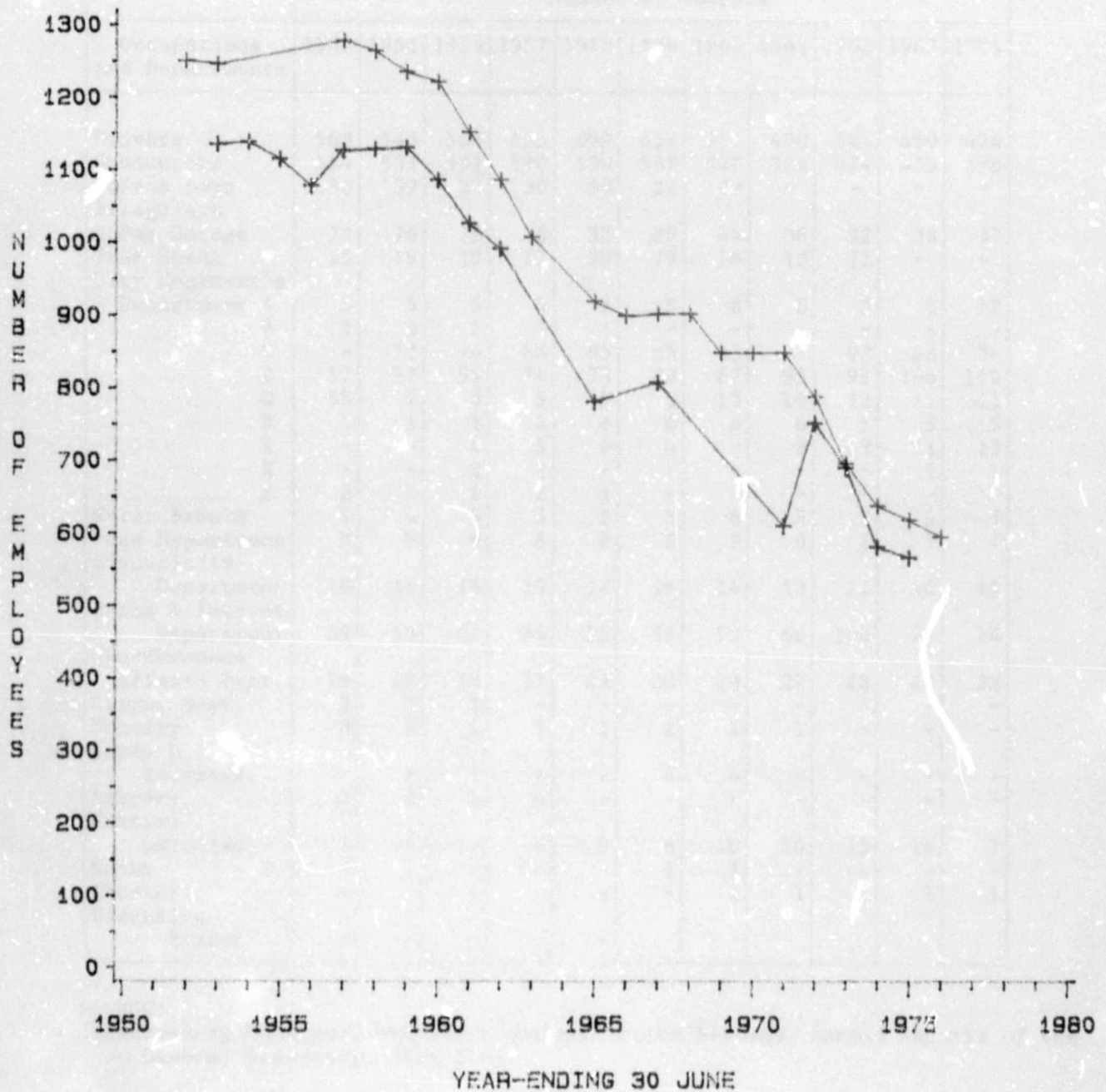

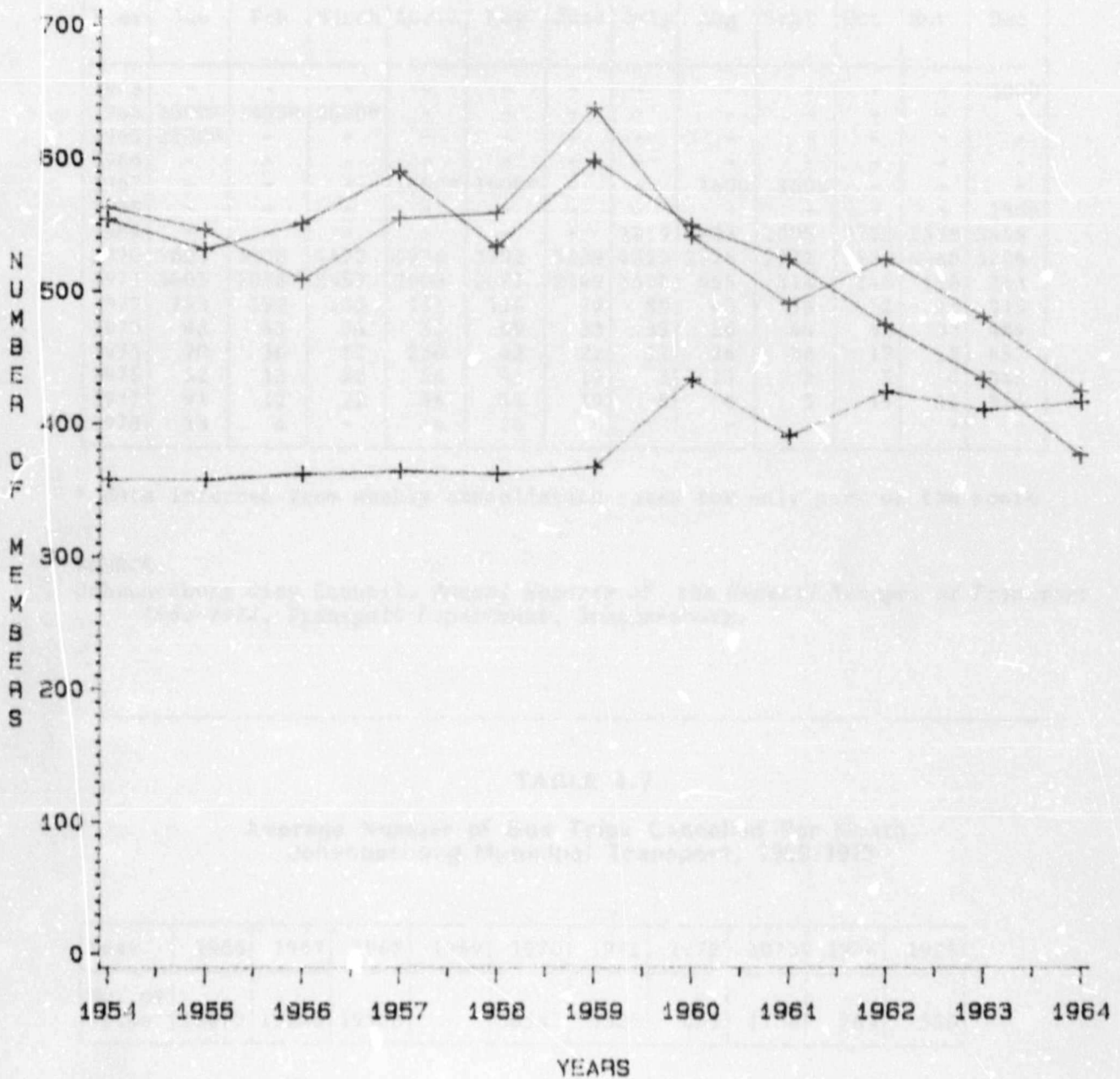

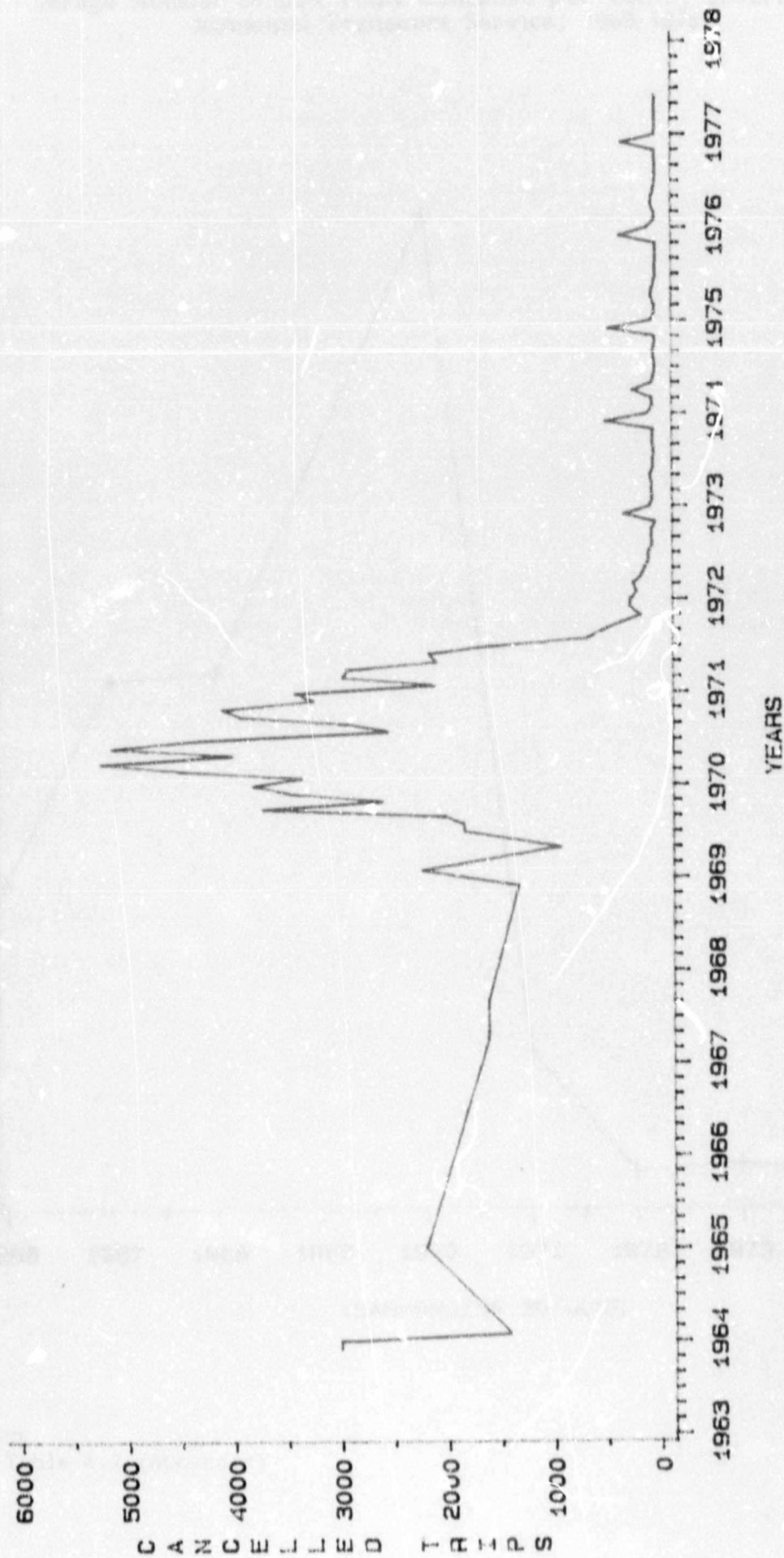

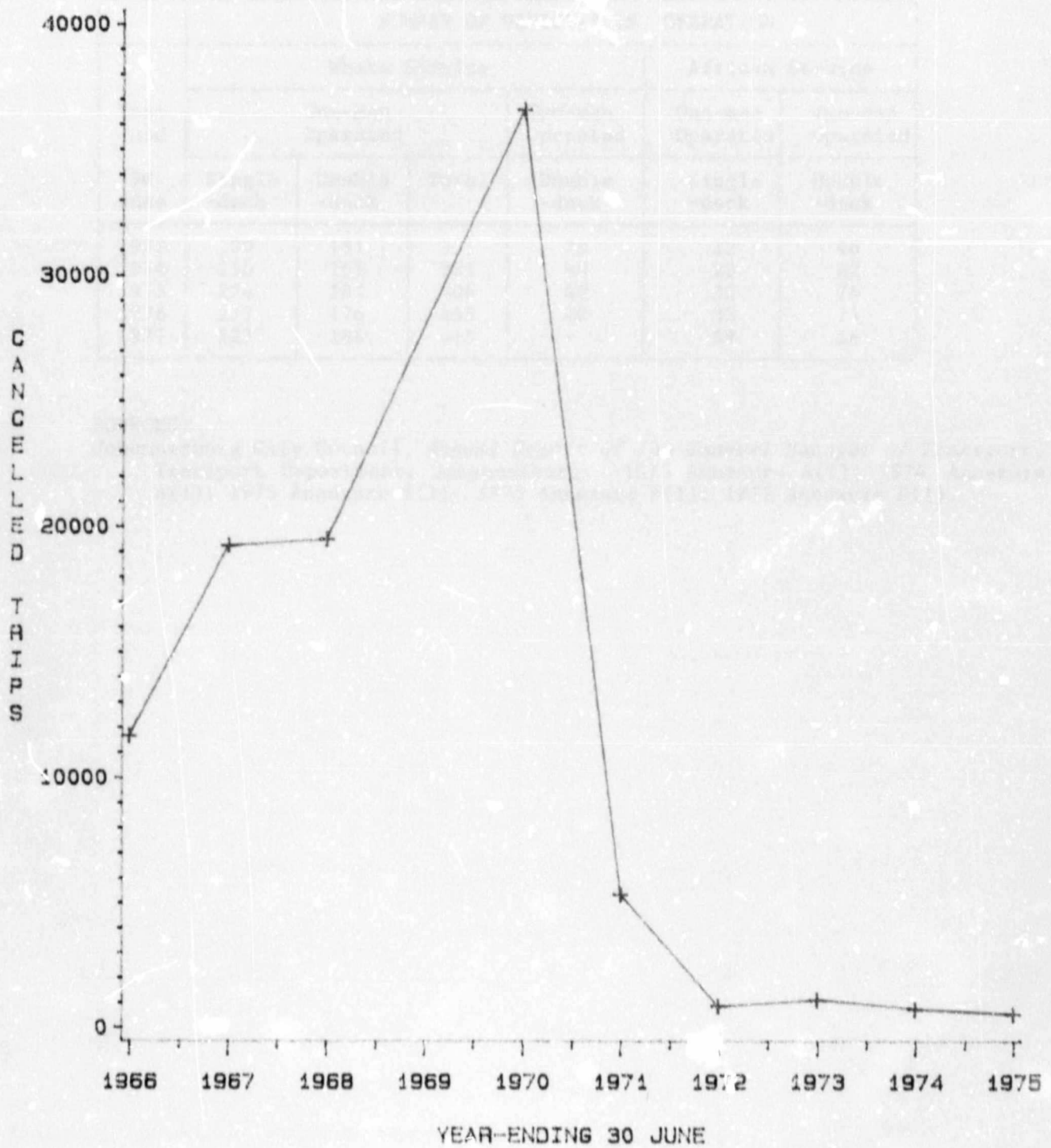

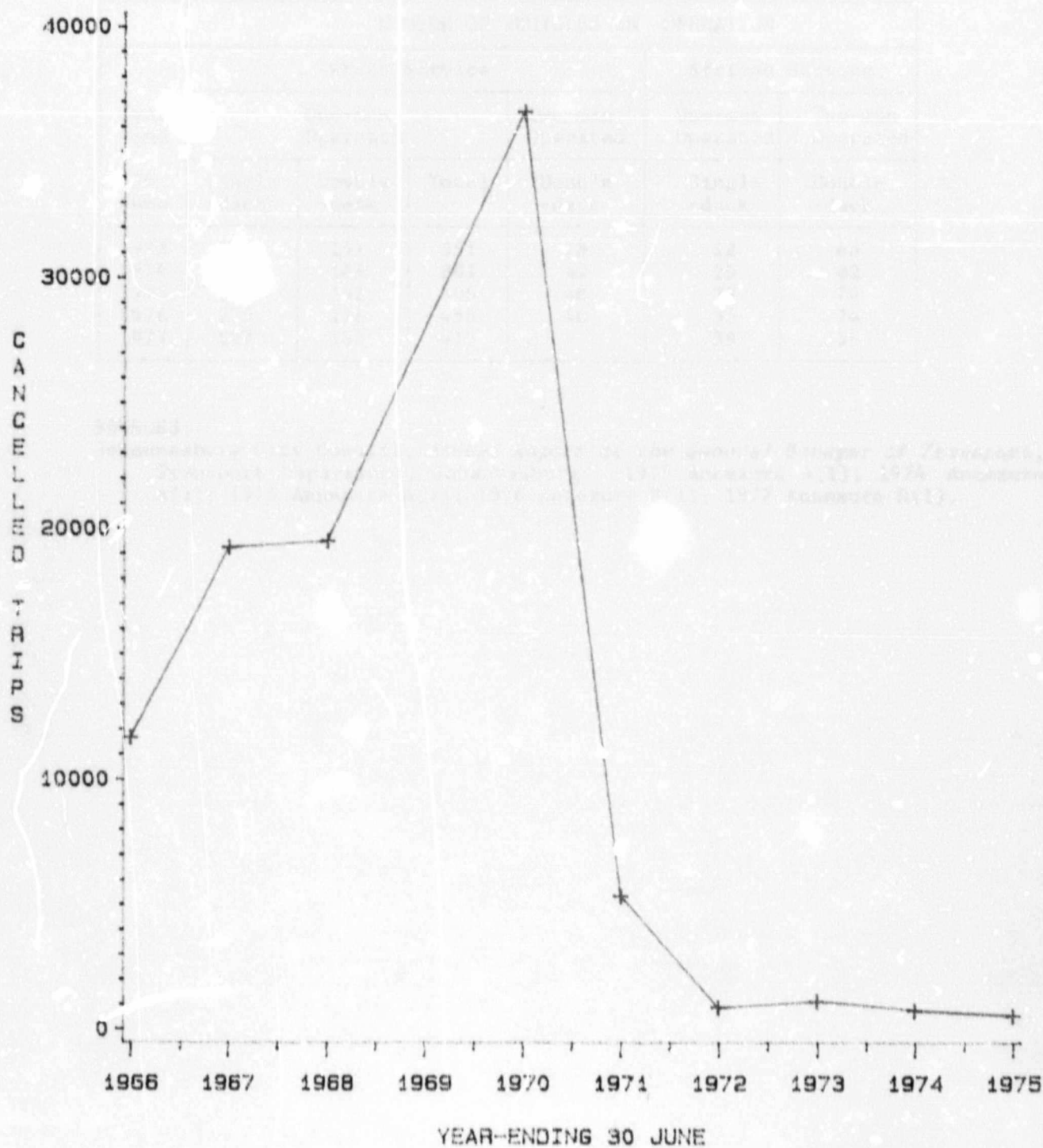
Average Number of Bus Trips Cancelled per Month, Johannesburg

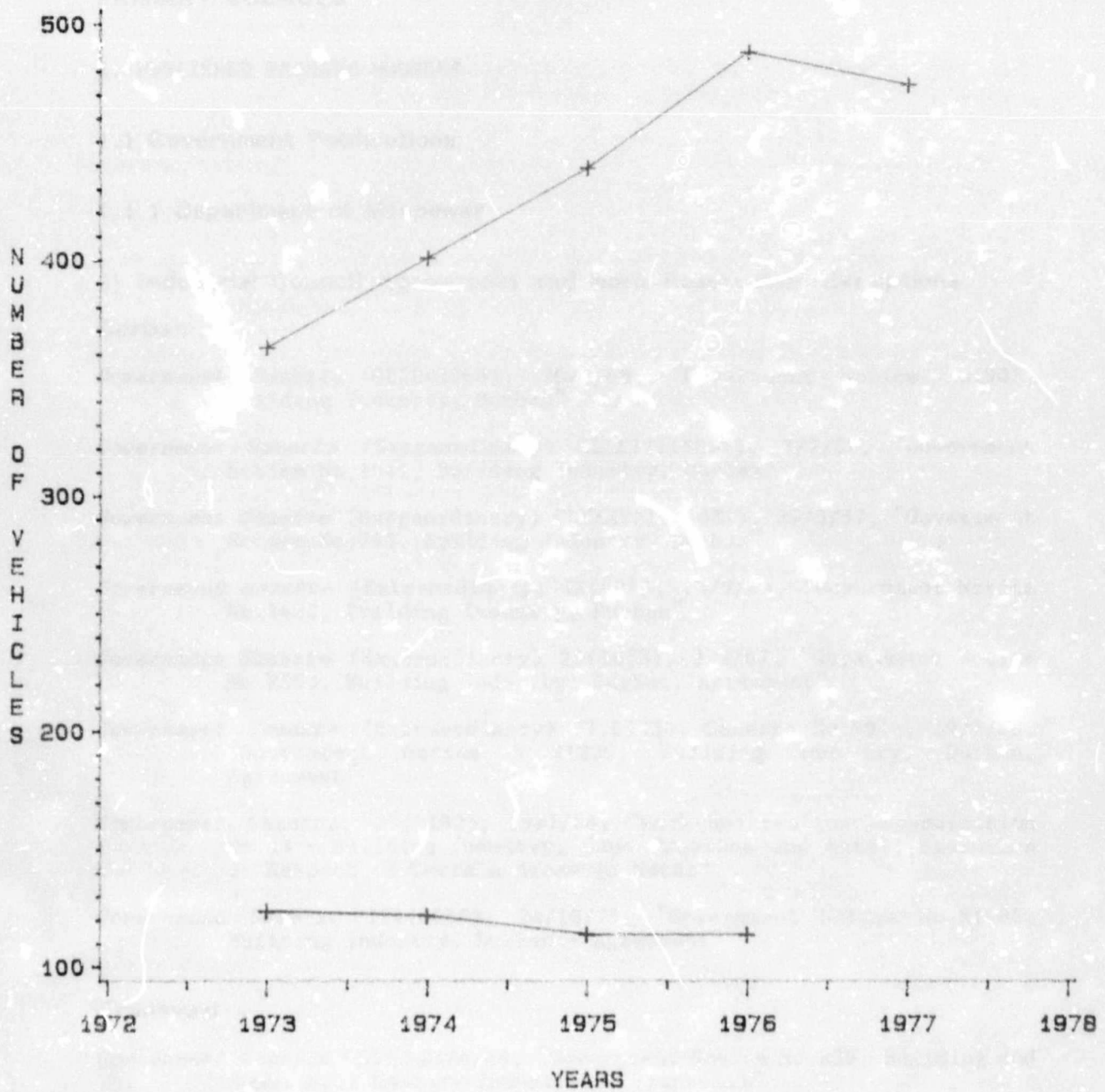
