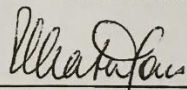

For one-to-one interviews

Dear Sir/Madam,

My name is Tarryn Lee and I am doing research on the building of Helen Joseph Hospital. The research will become a written paper and a final theatre production.

I am interviewing clinicians, care givers, patients and service providers. A maximum of 30 participants will be invited to join this study.

I invite you to join this research to answer some questions about the structure of the hospital building, surface changes and renovations in the building, and the affect these may have on the way you use the building. The information from the interview recording will be handled by the researcher only. I wish to only include your role: clinician, or care giver, or patient or service provider, in the final research should you consent to this.

If you agree to join this study, I would like to ask your consent to record your interview with video and sound recording. This information will be interpreted into the following art project: a theatre production. The recorded interview and your audio will not be reproduced or screened in the final theatre production. In the instance whereby the hospital space is recorded for research purposes independent of the video and audio recorded interview, human subjects will not be included. You may still be a part of the study if you choose not to be audio recorded or video recorded. I will be the only person to handle the recorded interview data to write a theatre script. There will be actors performing the theatre script. The actors will not have access to your recorded interview information. Your name will not be used in the final written paper or final theatre production.

The interview will require 30 minutes of your time on a scheduled day. The interview can be split into more than one interview to accommodate your available time. The interview will take place in a private consultation room in the Helen Joseph Hospital Urology Department. The interview is a one-to-one discussion between yourself and the researcher. I may require a follow-up interview at a further suitable time and then require your advised contact information. This contact information will remain confidential by the researcher. If you decide to take part and there are any questions you don't want to answer, you don't have to answer them – I can still work with you on the study if you would like.

The interview will take place between the 01 June 2016 and the 01 March 2017. Confidentiality of the information you give me will be protected and your information respected at all times. The information from the interview will be protected on a password-secured computer without access to a network. I will not use your name when storing this information, I will only use a code.

The information you give me will be used to make a theatre production. No direct information from your interview will be used without receiving your consent. If some of this text information is selected for interpretation in the final theatre production, I will show you the script part and scene. If this information is given your consent for use, you can be credited in the final research project. Your direct name does not need to be used in the final research project if you don't want this.

There are no risks to your role, or medical treatment if applicable, as provided through the Helen Joseph Hospital. Your participation is voluntary and there will be no penalties placed upon you. You may stop your commitment to this study at any time, and your information will be destroyed. There will be no

payment for your time, information, and commitment to the study. The written paper and final theatre production will be freely available to you and anyone else who is interested. The written paper and final theatre production will be shared online, in educational settings, and at research events and conferences.

If counselling support is required, I will assist by arranging an on-duty psychiatrist or counsellor to meet with you. I will make contact with you the following day and communicate this offer again should communicate a need for counselling support.
