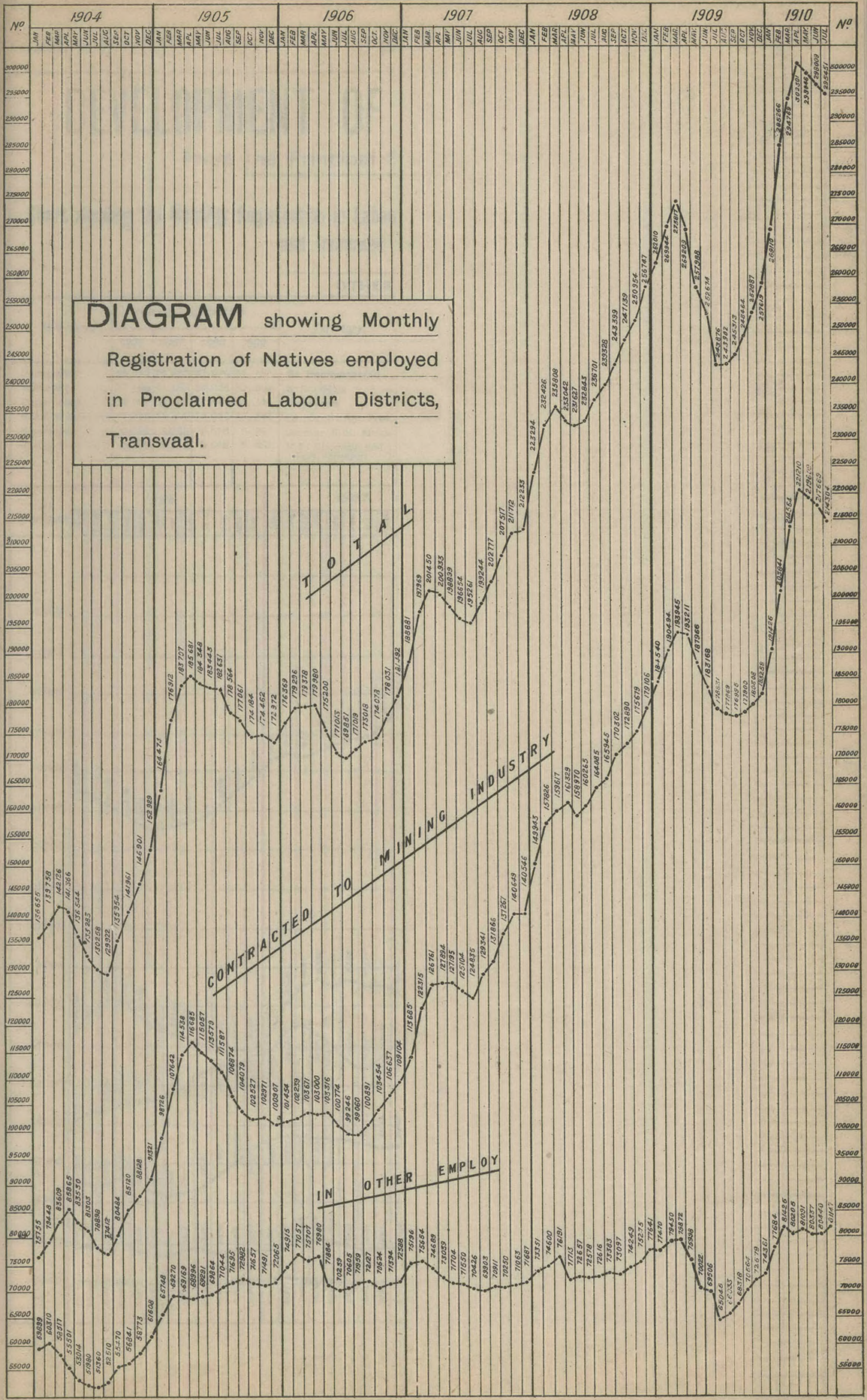

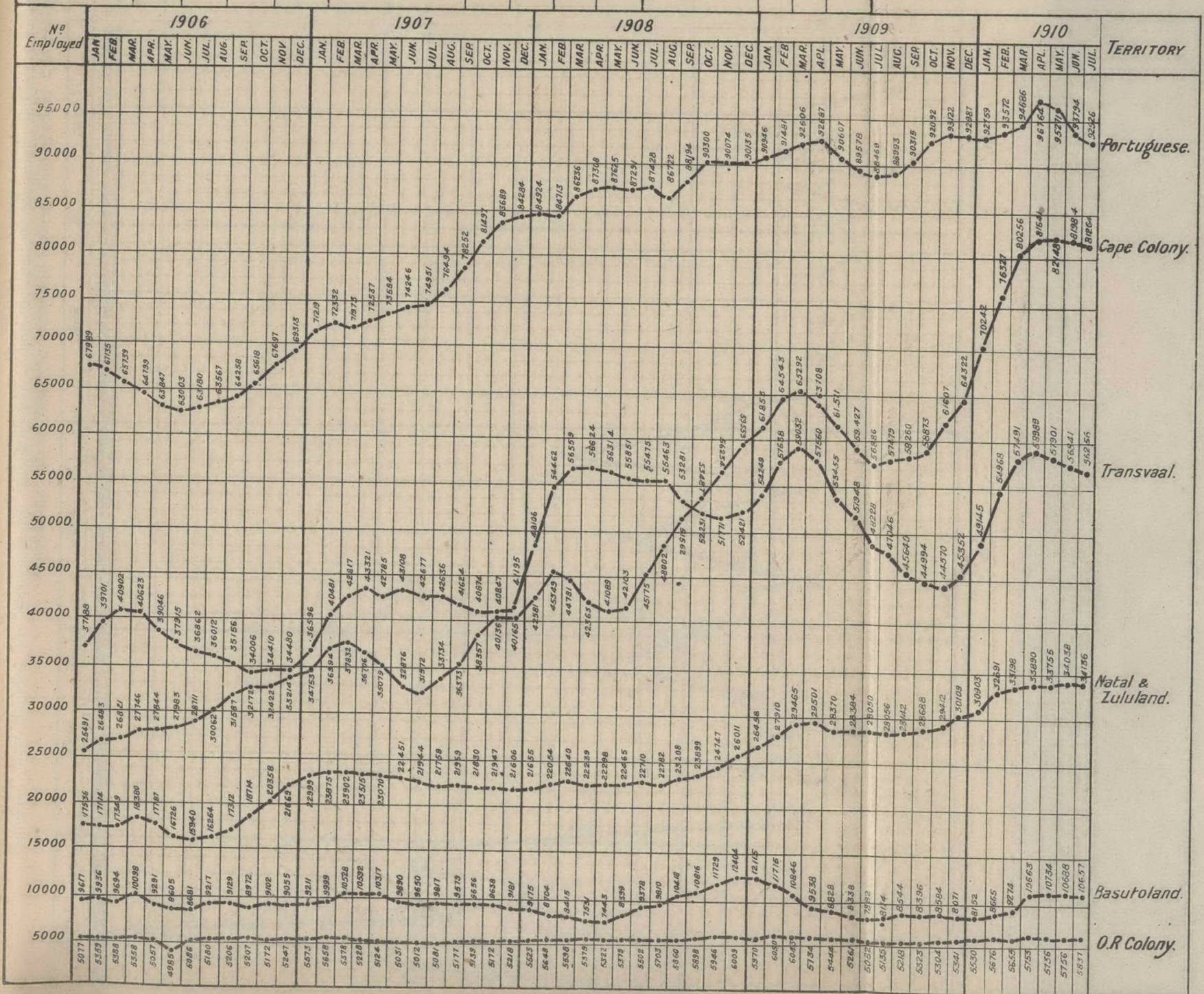


DEVELOPMENT OF NATIVE LABOUR

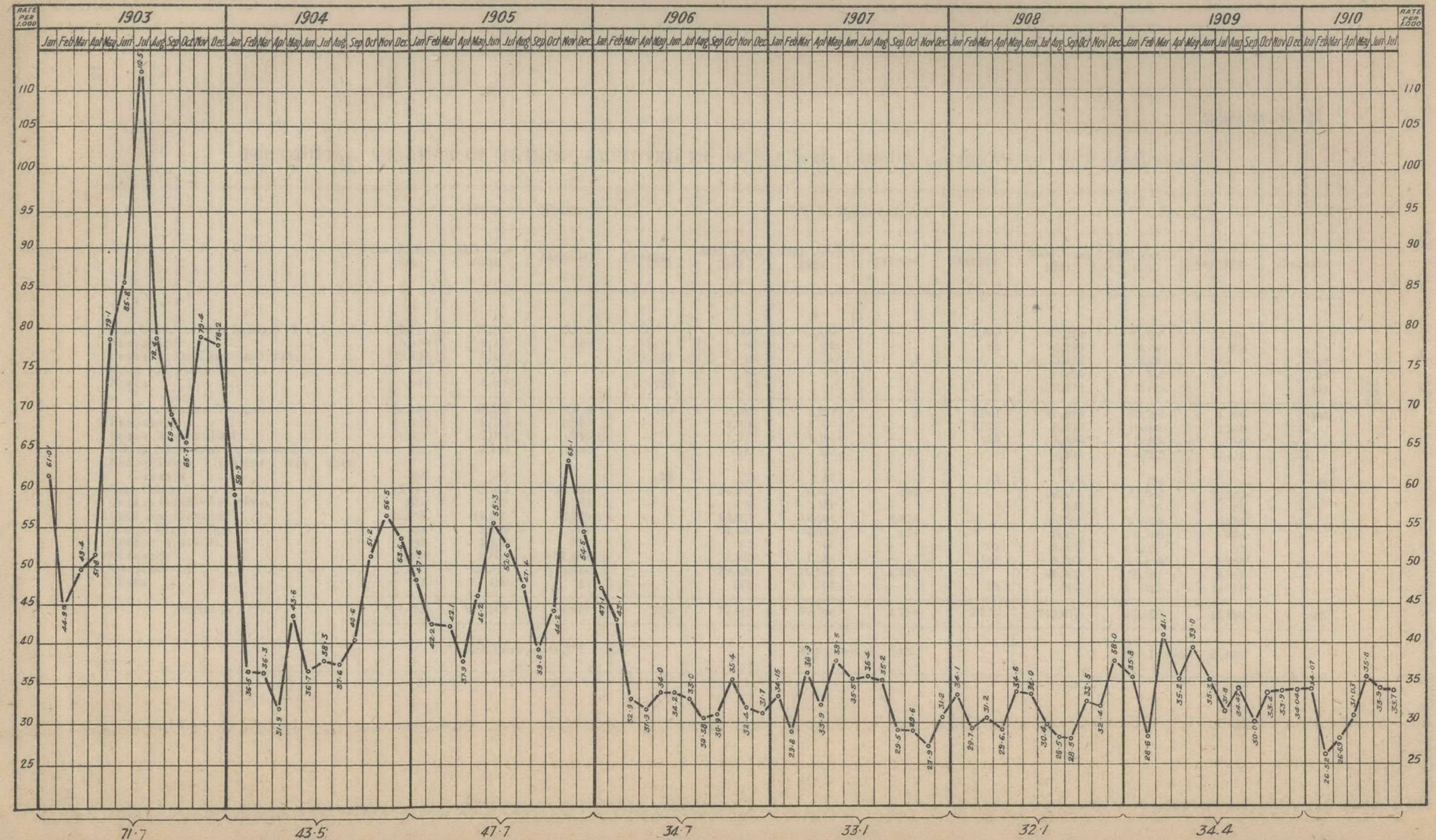
