The title of my PhD research is: *Exploring how values shape the entrepreneurial propensity of youths: a study of the young, black South African entrepreneur.* Specifically, I am interested in understanding how hybrid values (that is, the mix between traditional African and Western values) are used by youth entrepreneurs in the informal economy to secure entrepreneurial advantage and achieve entrepreneurial success.

What will happen if you choose to participate in the research?

- My research assistant will ask you to sign a consent form. By so doing, you agree to participate in the research. Before signing the form, please make sure that she has answered any questions you might have about the research.
- Your responses are important and there are no right or wrong answers. It would be appreciated if you answered all the questions. However, you may choose not to answer certain questions and you may stop answering the questionnaire at any stage.
- Your responses will be taken to be both confidential and anonymous. In order to ensure your confidentiality and anonymity, you will not be required to give your name or your business's name at any stage.
- Should you struggle to understand any of the questions, my research assistant will assist by translating them into a language you are comfortable with.
- This study is for academic purposes only. The results of the study will only be reported in my thesis as well as in journal articles, and your responses will not be shared with anyone else. Questionnaires will be kept for a period of 5 years in my office to facilitate further research, and will be destroyed thereafter.

What will happen if you choose <u>not</u> to participate in the research?
