OUTCOME OF THE DEGREE: MASTERS OF SCIENCE IN BUILDING

The reports from the examiners for your Masters of Science in Building research report entitled: *An assessment of factors influencing inadequate implementation of risk control and monitoring techniques*, have been evaluated and it was recommended that you undergo **substantial amendments to the satisfaction of the Supervisor and HoS.**

Please discuss, with your supervisor/s, the actions you need to take in light of the enclosed examiners' reports before submitting the corrected research report.

Please note that, according to the Standing Orders of the University (**A34**), candidates are entitled to appropriate supervision while revising their research report in response to examiners' reports. Revision shall be done within a **maximum period of six months**, unless application for a further extension is supported by the Faculty Graduate Studies Committee. Faculties will not require students to pay additional fees if revision is completed within three months. Beyond that, candidates will be required to pay all fees. Failure to submit at the end of the period allowed for revision may result in termination of candidature.

Once these corrections have been made, we require **2 single sided unbound copies** and an **electronic copy** of your **corrected research report**, a copy of your cover **page** and **abstract**, as well as the attached **final submission forms**.

Graduation takes place on **04 July 2018**. Please ensure that the required submission reaches the Faculty Office by **30 May 2018 (six weeks prior)** to this if you wish to graduate on the above mentioned date.

May I draw your attention to Rule G.30 which states the following:

1. A candidate upon whom a higher degree has been conferred by the University and who subsequently publishes or republishes the thesis, dissertation or other work, in whole or part, shall indicate on the title page or in the preface, or if this not appropriate, in a footnote, that such thesis, dissertation or other work has been approved for that degree by the University.
2. A candidate for a higher degree shall not be entitled to the return of the copies of the thesis, dissertation or other work which has been submitted for the degree.
