I trust that the above is in order.

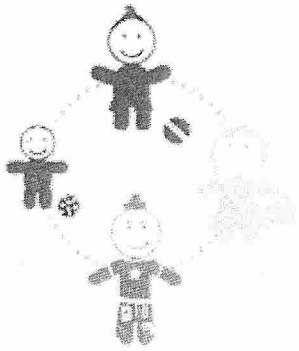

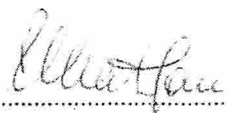
