INTERVIEW QUESTIONS GUIDE

Whenever I engaged with participants I always tried to clarify the purpose of my research and what I was hoping to achieve. Sometimes if need be I stated what I had done so far as a way of giving background to the study. I informed my interviewee/s that I would be jotting down notes as well as told the same to participants when I observed lessons. In my interviews with participants and facilitators some of the issues I asked included the following:

- 1) How did you learn about the existence of Kha Ri Gude?
- 2) What do you like most in the programme?
- 3) What is your home language and what other languages do you speak?
- 4) What would you like to be done differently in Kha Ri Gude?
- 5) What channels are there for you to express your views or suggestions for the betterment of the programme?
