

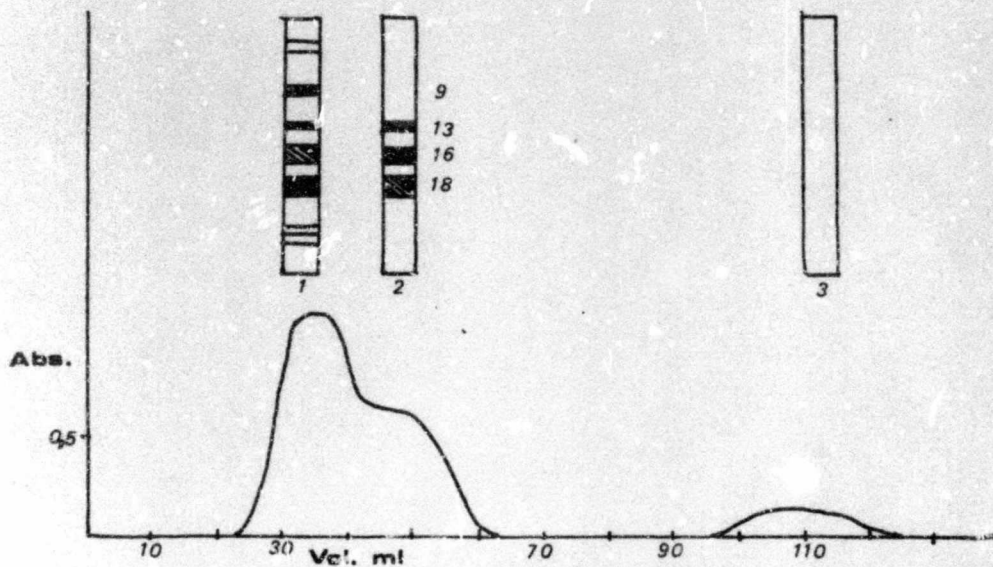


Fig. 18. Elution pattern of *L. capensis* protein on Sephadex G-100.
Tris-HCl buffer, pH 7,5.

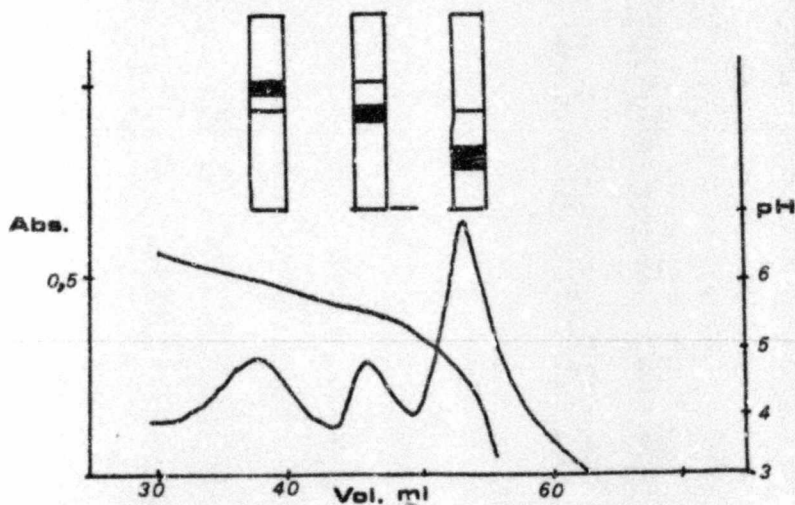


Fig. 19. Isoelectric focusing of sample 2 in fig. 18.

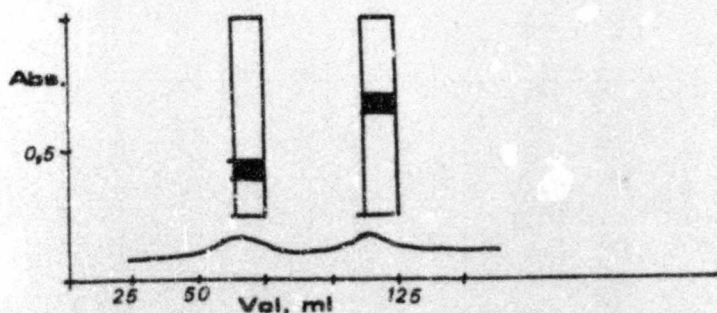


Fig. 20. Elution pattern of fractions 13 and 16 obtained by preparative gel electrophoresis with SDS.

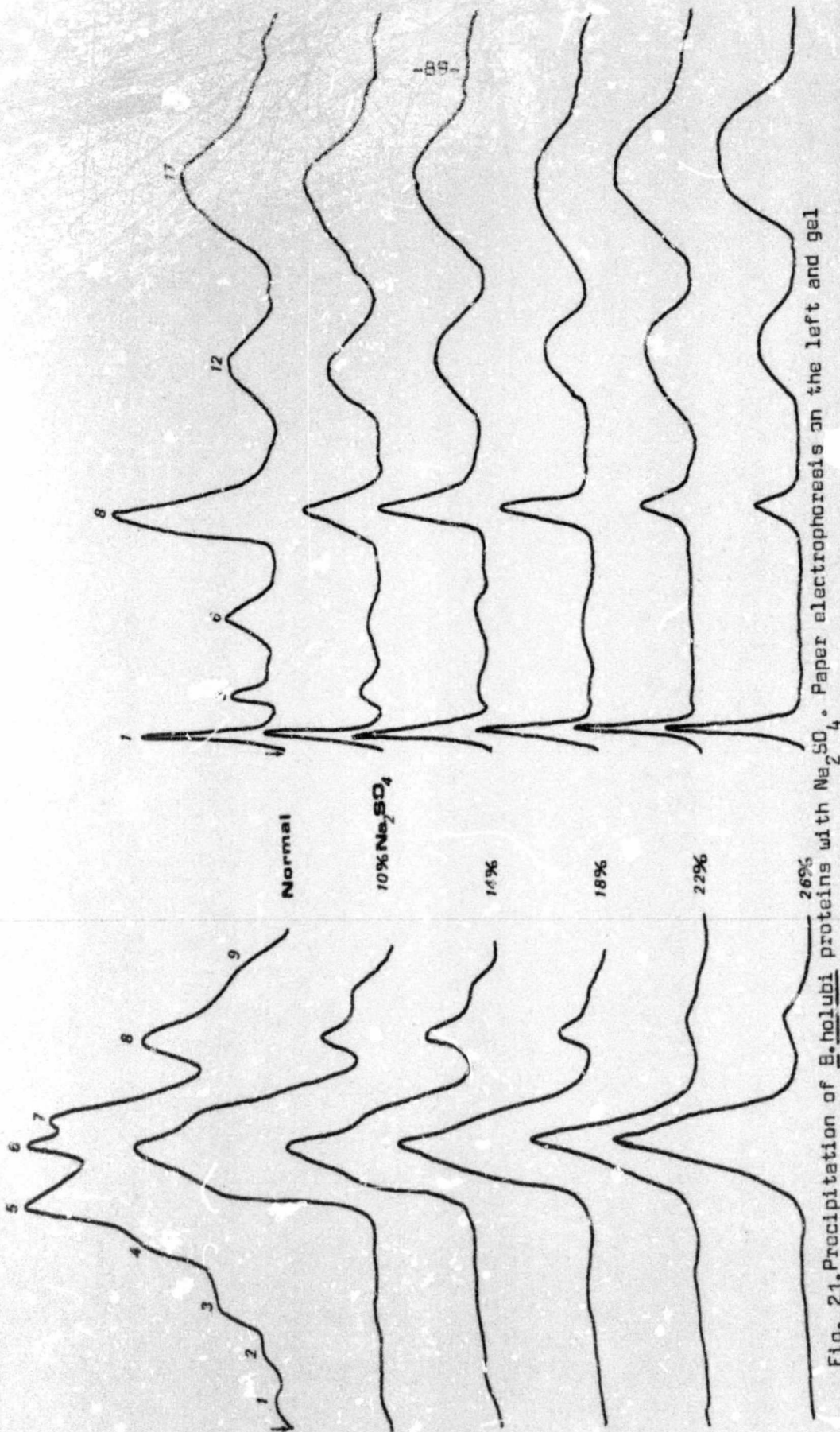


Fig. 21. Precipitation of *E. coli* proteins with Na₂SO₄. Paper electrophoresis on the left and gel electrophoresis on the right.

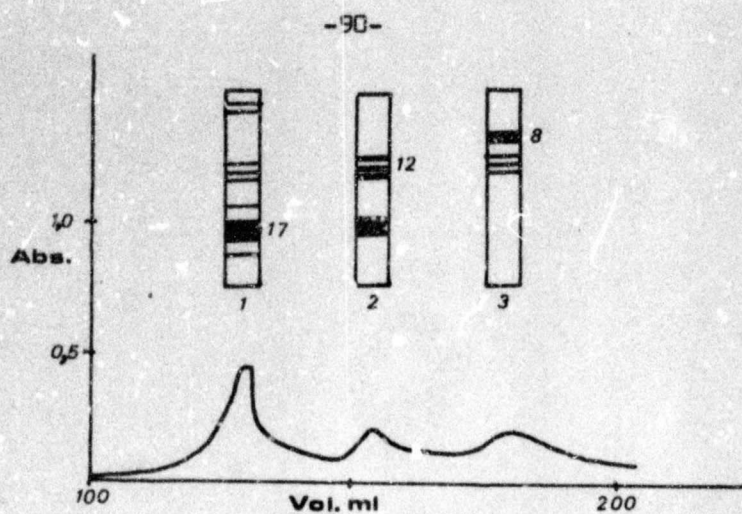


Fig. 22. Elution pattern of B. holubi protein on Sephadex G-100.
Tris-HCl buffer, pH 8,0

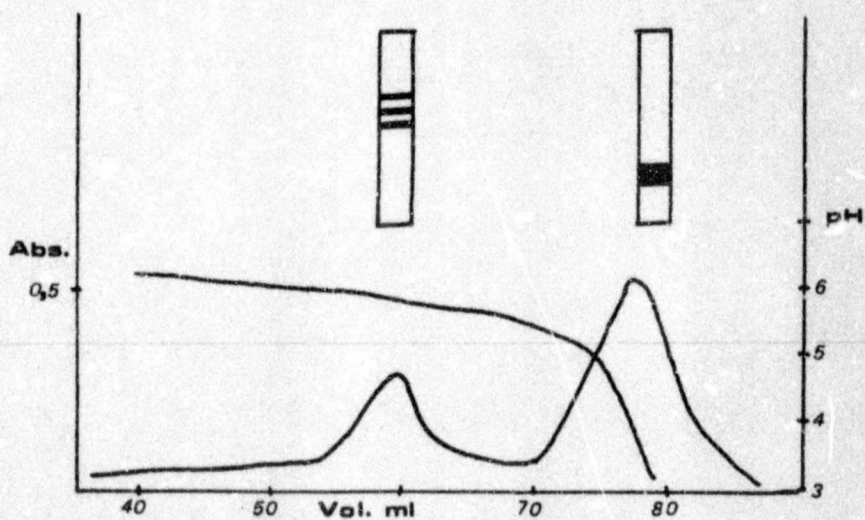
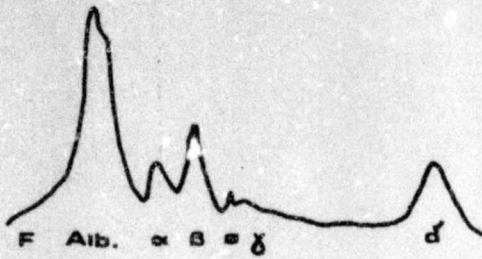


Fig. 23. Isoelectric focusing of sample 2 in fig. 22.

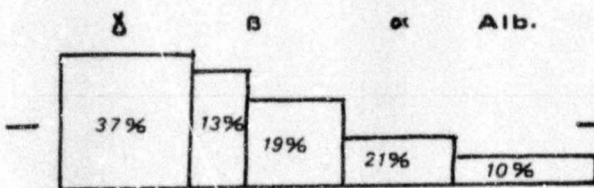
