A unit to implement energy efficiency must be formed within DME to ensure implementation -Not in favour of another government agency – it is just another layer of unnecessary bureaucracy, which presents an opportunity for a highly paid public servant.
3	Energy pricing	• How does the current low electricity pricing affect implementation of energy efficiency? ○ Role of Eskom monopoly ○ How can it be corrected	-Eskom cannot be a coach, referee and player in the same game – we might just as well all go home -Eskom cannot pull out completely from the energy efficiency challenge. However it needs to be restructured and the creation of REDS is a step in the right direction.
