19. Nina Oh the x . Oh, you using the x for the first one because they don't give you...
20. Siphon No, no, no, no... they're not giving you... err, they are not giving you the... umm, thingy... the...
21. Nina ... the length.
22. Gio ... oh, ja, ja...
23. Siphon ... the breadth, so you take, use the x ... and my x ...

Stanza 7

24. Siphon ... my answers, I got one metres, one metre for the breadth...
25. Gio ... it needs two answers... the length and the breadth...
26. Siphon Yeah, for the breadth I got one, one metre, and for the length I got three metres.
27. Nina Correct, I got two for the breadth and one for the length.

Stanza 8

28. Siphon ... so what x do's...
29. Gio So which one is, is right then?
30. Nina I think Siphon. There's no logic, because I didn't use the x .

Stanza 9

31. Gio Number two I think is easy...
32. Nina Number two... [inaudible]... because in five days you can pay..., like if you rent for five days in this you gonna pay for six days, the money that you should take together is exactly six days in the, the Clear Vision.
33. Siphon Wait wait wait wait...
34. Gio How do you get this?
35. Nina Because, just remember, the Clear Vision's more expensive the fee, which you only pay once, but here the Best View the rent is more expensive, and the rent you pay every day... that's R50... the rent's four times, its like four times... ummm... R15, so you can pay, the rent you can pay here for one day you can pay for four days at Clear Vision.

Stanza 10

36. Gio ... so here you, you subtract... or what...
37. Nina No, you don't... we just say, I'm just saying if you rent the TV in Best View for one day you pay four days of rent in Clear Vision. Which, if you pay the fees in Clear Vision, you pay the fees, 150, that's will be 15 days in Best View. It's very clear.

41. Gio But here they say for what number of days, for what number...
42. Nina I used five days because you, if you rent, if you rent in the Clear Vision you save more of money, because you need rent for five days. In Clear Vision you pay R225, which if you paid for five days in the Best View you pay 315, and that means you pay for six days in...

45. Nina ... where did you subtract from?

46. Gio I took the 75, the, the 165 minus 75 to get the number, to get the...

47. Nina ... but the equation was...

48. [Sipho and Nina chorus] what number of days...

49. Nina ... not of one day, not of... What number of days?

50. Gio This good now, horrible imaginations about a lot of hyenas, isn't it? [General chuckles].

Stanza 15

51. Gio Okay, problem number three.

52. Sipho Okay, problem number three, what did you do?

53. Nina I took 32, coz 32 kilometres [chuckling]... and I got, I think 8 kilometres. I was just guessing... I don't know...

54. Gio No, I did, I did one, one minute per 60 seconds, right? So I did 60 times 15 is... 900. So I took the 32 minus 24, which gave me 8, times twenty...

55. Nina Oh, 28.

Stanza 16

56. Sipho Oh, okay, okay, my mistake, I found my mistake. I...err... I...

57. Gio ... you found it...

58. Sipho Yeah, yeah...

Stanza 17

59. Gio [Addressing Nina whilst Sipho works through his solution to Problem 3] ... then 8 times 15 which gave me 120, divided by two...

60. Nina Then how many kilometres?

61. Gio 60 kilometres. Okay...

62. Nina 60 kilometres.

Stanza 18

63. Sipho Okay. What I did is, umm totally different to what you guys did. You know, umm you take distance, distance is equals to speed divided by time...

64. Gio Speed, dis... you're talking about science here, right?
65. Siphon Ah, but still. Okay, so distance is equal to speed divided by time, so I took, umm, 32 kilometres and I plussed it with, umm 24, and then I took, umm...

Stanza 19

66. Siphon My mistake was I should have put in, I should have made 15 con..., I should have converted it.
67. Gio Yes. 15 should have been in...
68. Siphon ... 15 should have been divided, should have been... what's 15...?
69. Gio Should be times, shouldn't it?
70. Siphon 15, 15, 15... mmm... is equals to a quarter, divided by a quarter of umm 60 minutes, 60 divided by...
71. Gio So what's your answer?
72. Siphon It should be 60 divided by, err, divided by four, and then this, that divided by... err, then you would have gotten your answer there, and then you take... umm... 4, it'll be 4, 4 divided by 32 kilometres and you'll get your distance that he had to travel. I think, I'm not sure, but... I could have...

73. Gio For me this problem is, mmm very difficult.

78. Siphon I, err... donno...
79. Gio I think in the future we won't use it, maybe I going to...
80. Siphon I think you going to use it... later...
81. Nina You going to be a maths teacher you going to use it...
82. Siphon Nooo...
83. Gio Of course! ... My father's a businessman, right, he just use minus, plus, times... he doesn't use, he doesn't use...
84. Nina ... the x , y ... triangles, circles...

Stanza 22

85. Siphon But I think, you know you need a formula like, umm, as a businessman you'd say, like you wanna, somebody asks you and says... err, I wanna buy an orange, let's say I wanna buy an orange, for... so much money, how much more, how much, how much money would I need if I wanna buy, let's say, 10 oranges? Then you gonna need to know...
