May I draw your attention to Rule G.9.6 which states that

- (1) *a candidate upon whom a higher degrees has been conferred by the University and who subsequently publishes or republishes his/her thesis, dissertation or other work, in whole or in part, shall indicate on the title page or in the preface, or if this is not appropriate, in a footnote that such thesis, dissertation or other work has been approved for that degree by the University.*
- (2) *a candidate for a higher degree shall not be entitled to the return of the copies of the thesis, dissertation or other work which he/she has submitted for the degree.*

All students must remain registered for each academic year until completion of any corrections!
